GET HELP: Gift & Toy Programs



If you are currently receiving services through a community organization, it is suggested that you contact them directly about their holiday assistance programs available to their clients. Other organizations that offer help are listed below.

Parents or guardians of children can apply for the Gift and Toy programs listed below. When registering, you must provide 3 pieces of identification showing street address along with proof of income, (including Child Tax Benefit or GST Rebate) and birth certificate/dates of each child living in the home. Eligibility for Gift and Toy programs will be determined by the individual organization.

GET HELP: Food Baskets



If you are on a low income, and need assistance with food during the holiday season, you can contact one of the following organizations to apply for a Holiday Food Basket. You must provide two pieces of personal identification (which include name, address and apartment number), recent income statement, proof of residency (rent receipt or utility bill) plus proof of age for each child living in the home. Eligibility for Food Baskets will be determined by the individual organization. If leaving a message, please be sure to provide your name and return phone number.
